
We can recommend a range of Isle of Wight suppliers to you, who can support with decorations, flowers, music and live entertainment and all essential detail to make your big day extra special.






Seminar Room

You will then need to contact the Isle of Wight Register Office to make a booking for a Registrar to attend your ceremony. Once you have received confirmation that a registrar can attend on the provisional date, please complete a Quay Arts Booking Form and return it to us with the deposit.

#### Insurance

Insurance does not hold the same romance as choosing flowers, rings or a dress, however, to ensure that you are covered for the unexpected, we strongly recommend that you take out insurance cover as soon as you put a deposit down for the event.

### Music for the service

Music at the beginning of the service is permitted, providing it is secular. Please ensure the Registrar knows and has approved your music choice.
